

ORDINANCE NO. O-19-12  
TOWNSHIP MEETING DATE – June 25, 2019

ORDINANCE AMENDING CHAPTER 190 (LAND USE), ARTICLE XII, (GENERAL ZONING PROVISIONS) BY ADDING SECTION 190-124.4 (EMERGENCY STANDBY GENERATORS FOR FILLING STATIONS) AND AMENDING SECTION 190-197.1 (GASOLINE FILLING STATIONS WITH CONVENIENCE STORES) OF THE REVISED GENERAL ORDINANCES OF THE TOWNSHIP OF FREEHOLD, COUNTY OF MONMOUTH, STATE OF NEW JERSEY

BE IT ORDAINED by the Township Committee of the Township of Freehold, County of Monmouth, State of New Jersey, as follows:

**I**

Chapter 190, Land Use, Article XII, General Zoning Provisions, is hereby amended by adding Section 190-124.4, Emergency Standby Generators for Filling Stations, to read as follows:

**190-124.4 Emergency standby generators for filling stations.**

Any gasoline filling station, gasoline service station, gasoline filling stations with convenience stores or any other location dispensing gasoline and diesel fuel to the public shall have an appropriately sized Emergency Standby Generator System as defined in Section 190-3, capable of operating fuel pumps, cash registers and lighted signs in the event of power outage for at least 18 hours. Separate convenience store facilities need not have an Emergency Standby Generator System, to the extent that the facilities set forth herein have such a system.

**II**

Chapter 190, Land Use, Article XII, General Zoning Provisions, Section 190-197.1, Gasoline Filling Stations with Convenience Stores, is hereby amended and supplemented by adding Section 190-197.1 P., Gasoline Filling Stations with Convenience Stores, to read as follows:

**190-197.1 Gasoline filling stations with convenience stores.**

A. - O. No change.

P. Any gasoline filling station, gasoline service station, gasoline filling stations with convenience stores dispensing gasoline and diesel fuel to the public shall have an appropriately sized Emergency Standby Generator System as defined in Section 190-3, capable of operating fuel pumps, cash registers and lighted signs in the event of power outage for at least 18 hours.

Separate convenience store facilities need not have an Emergency Standby Generator System, to the extent that the facilities set forth herein have such a system.

**III**

All Ordinances and parts of Ordinances inconsistent herewith are hereby repealed.

**IV**

If any section, subparagraph, sentence, clause or phrase of this Ordinance shall be held to be invalid, such decision shall not invalidate the remaining portion of this Ordinance.

**V**

This Ordinance shall take effect upon adoption and publication according to law and filing with the Monmouth County Planning Board.

**EXPLANATORY STATEMENT:**

This Ordinance requires that any gasoline filling station, gasoline service station, gasoline filling stations with convenience stores or any other location dispensing gasoline and diesel fuel to the public shall have an appropriately sized Emergency Standby Generator System.

TOWNSHIP MEETING DATE – JUNE 25, 2019**

**AN ORDINANCE APPROPRIATING THE SUM OF \$80,000 CURRENTLY LOCATED WITHIN THE WATER AND SEWER UTILITY CAPITAL IMPROVEMENT FUND OF THE TOWNSHIP OF FREEHOLD FOR IMPROVEMENTS TO THE JOYSAN PUMP STATION AND GULLY ROAD PUMP STATION WITHIN THE WATER AND SEWER UTILITY DEPARTMENT**

WHEREAS, there is currently within the Water and Sewer Utility Capital Fund of the Township of Freehold an item entitled Capital Improvement Fund; and

WHEREAS, there is in this Fund at least \$80,000; and

WHEREAS, it is deemed appropriate to make use of the \$80,000 to Replace Joysan Pump Station Mixer and Rebuild Pumps at the Gully Road Pump Station within the Water and Sewer Utility Department;

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the Township Committee of the Township of Freehold, County of Monmouth, State of New Jersey, that:

SECTION 1. There is hereby appropriated from the Capital Improvement Fund contained within the Water and Sewer Utility Capital Budget of the Township of Freehold, the sum of \$80,000 to the Replace Joysan Pump Station Mixer and Rebuild Pumps at the Gully Road Pump Station within the Water and Sewer Utility Department.

SECTION 2. In connection with the purpose and the amount authorized in Section 1 hereof, the Township of Freehold determines the purpose described in Section 1 is not a Current Expense and is an improvement which the Township of Freehold may lawfully make as a general improvement.

SECTION 3. All Ordinances or parts of Ordinances which are inconsistent with the terms of this Ordinance be and the same are hereby repealed to the extent of inconsistency.

SECTION 4. This Ordinance shall take effect immediately upon proper passage and publication in accordance with law.

**EXPLANATION**

The purpose is to make use of the \$80,000 from the Water and Sewer Capital Improvement Fund to Replace Joysan Pump Station Mixer and Rebuild Pumps at the Gully Road Pump Station within the Water and Sewer Utility Department.

**ORDINANCE NO. O-19-14**

**TOWNSHIP MEETING DATE – JULY 9, 2019**

**ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING THE LEASING OF CERTAIN CAPITAL EQUIPMENT BY THE TOWNSHIP OF FREEHOLD, NEW JERSEY FROM THE MONMOUTH COUNTY IMPROVEMENT AUTHORITY AND THE EXECUTION OF A LEASE AND AGREEMENT RELATING THERETO**

BE IT ORDAINED by the Township Committee of the Township of Freehold, New Jersey (not less than two-thirds of all members thereof affirmatively concurring) as follows:

Section 1. Pursuant to Section 78 of the County Improvement Authorities Law, N.J.S.A. 40:37A-44, et seq., the Township of Freehold (the “Municipality”) is hereby authorized to unconditionally and irrevocably lease certain items of capital equipment from The Monmouth County Improvement Authority (the “Authority”) pursuant to a Lease and Agreement, substantially in the form submitted to this meeting (the “Lease”), a copy of which is on file in the office of the Clerk to the Municipality. The Mayor is hereby authorized to execute the Lease on behalf of the Municipality in substantially such form as submitted to this meeting and with such changes as may be approved by the Mayor, which approval shall be conclusively evidenced by the execution thereof, and the Clerk to the Municipality is hereby authorized to affix and attest the seal of the Municipality.

Section 2. The following additional matters are hereby determined, declared, recited and stated:

- (a) In recognition of the fact that the lease payment of the Municipality under the Lease will be based, in part, on the amount of bonds issued by the Authority to finance the acquisition of the leased equipment and the interest thereon, the maximum amount of bonds which the Authority shall issue to finance the acquisition of the equipment to be leased to the Municipality shall not exceed \$1,765,000 and the interest rate on said bonds shall not exceed five and fifty hundredths percent (5.50%) per annum;
- (b) The items to be leased from the Authority shall be as set forth in Schedule A hereto; provided that the Mayor or any authorized municipal representative (as defined in the Lease) may substitute or add items of equipment in accordance with the provisions of the Lease; and
- (c) The lease term applicable to a particular item of leased equipment shall not exceed the useful life of such item.

Section 3. This ordinance shall take effect twenty (20) days after the first publication thereof after final adoption as provided by law.

WHEREAS, N.J.S.A. 40A:5-4 requires the governing body of every local unit to have made an annual audit of its books, accounts and financial transactions, and,

WHEREAS, the Annual Report of Audit for the year 2018 has been filed by a Registered Municipal Accountant with the Municipal Clerk pursuant to N.J.S.A. 40A: 5-6, and a copy has been received by each member of the Governing Body; and,

WHEREAS, R.S. 52:27BB-34 authorizes the Local Finance Board of the State of New Jersey to prescribe reports pertaining to the local fiscal affairs; and,

WHEREAS, the Local Finance Board has promulgated N.J.A.C. 5:30-6.5, a regulation requiring that the governing body of each municipality shall by resolution certify to the Local Finance Board of the State of New Jersey that all members of the governing body have reviewed, as a minimum, the sections of the annual audit entitled "Comments and Recommendations;" and,

WHEREAS, the members of the Governing Body have personally reviewed as a minimum, the Annual Report of Audit, and specifically the sections of the Annual Audit entitled "Comments and Recommendations", as evidenced by the group affidavit form of the Governing Body attached hereto; and,

WHEREAS, such Resolution of certification shall be adopted by the Governing Body no later than forty-five days (45) after receipt of the annual audit, pursuant to N.J.A.C. 5:30-6.5; and,

WHEREAS, all members of the Governing Body have received and have familiarized themselves with, at least, the minimum requirements of the Local Finance Board of the State of New Jersey, as stated aforesaid and have subscribed to the affidavit, as provided by the Local Finance Board; and

WHEREAS, failure to comply with the regulations of the Local Finance Board of the State of New Jersey may subject the members of the local Governing Body to the penalty provisions of R.S. 52:27BB-52, to wit:

R.S. 52:27BB-52: A local officer or member of a local governing body who, after a date fixed for compliance, fails or refuses to obey an order of the director (Director of Local Government Services), under the provisions of this Article, shall be guilty of a misdemeanor and, upon conviction, may be fined not more than one thousand dollars (\$1,000.00) or imprisoned for not more than one year or both, in addition shall forfeit his office.
