ORDINANCE NO. O-21-17
TOWNSHIP MEETING DATE – October 26, 2021

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING CHAPTER 190, LAND USE, ARTICLE XI ZONES AND SCHEDULE OF REQUIREMENTS, AND ARTICLE XIII, ZONING REGULATIONS, OF THE REVISED GENERAL ORDINANCES OF THE TOWNSHIP OF FREEHOLD, COUNTY OF MONMOUTH, STATE OF NEW JERSEY

BE IT ORDAINED by the Township Committee of the Township of Freehold, County of Monmouth, and State of New Jersey as follows:

I

PURPOSES: The purposes of this Ordinance are to amend Chapter 190, Land Use, Article XI, Zones and Schedule of Requirements, and Article XIII Zoning Regulations to rezone designated parcels from R-80 and R-E to the R-15 and R-E Zones and to add a zoning provision to §190-135 and Schedule C for new subdivisions on larger properties with the R-15 zone.

Note: Additions are underlined and deletions are shown with ~~strikethroughs~~.

II

Article XI, Zones and Schedule of Requirements Regulations, §190-98 Zoning Map, is hereby amended to rezone the following block and lots from R-80 and R-E to R-15 and R-E as follows and as depicted on a map entitled “R-15 and R-E Zoning” dated July 29, 2021 and prepared by Thomas Planning Associates, LLC:

Article XI, Zones and Schedule of Requirements Regulations, §190-101 Schedule of Area, Yard and Bulk Requirements, Schedule C, is hereby amended to add footnote #25 to the schedule for the R-15 Zone as shown in the attached amendment.

IV

Article XIII, Zoning Regulations, §190-135, Residential Zone R-15, is hereby amended to add item E. as indicated:

§190-135 Residential Zone R-15.

- A. Permitted uses: same as for R-25 Zone.
- B. Permitted accessory uses: same as for R-25 Zone, except that private garages shall not exceed a maximum of two automotive vehicles' capacity whether attached and/or within a freestanding building, which garaging area shall not exceed 24 feet by 24 feet and 576 square feet.
- C. Uses permitted subject to issuance of a conditional use permit: same as for R-25 Zone.
- D. Area, yard and building requirements: as specified in Schedule C at the end of this chapter.
- E. Major subdivisions occurring after the time of adoption of this subsection and containing a total tract area of 15 acres or greater may reduce the following R-15 zoning requirements as shown in Schedule C – Area, Yard and Building Requirements:
 - (1) Minimum lot width at building line - 80' for interior lots; 100' for corner lots.
 - (2) Minimum front yard setback – principal building –35ft.

All ordinances and parts of ordinances inconsistent herewith are hereby repealed.


If any section, paragraph, sentence, clause or phrase of this ordinance shall be held to be invalid, such decision shall not invalidate any remaining portion of this ordinance.



ORDINANCE AMENDING CHAPTER 51 (POLICE DEPARTMENT), SECTION 51-9 (DUTIES AND RESPONSIBILITIES OF POLICE DEPARTMENT) OF THE REVISED GENERAL ORDINANCES OF THE TOWNSHIP OF FREEHOLD, COUNTY OF MONMOUTH, STATE OF NEW JERSEY

BE IT ORDAINED by the Township Committee of the Township of Freehold, County of Monmouth, State of New Jersey, as follows: (additions are underlined, and deletions are in [brackets]):

I

Chapter 51, Police Department, Section 51-9, Duties and responsibilities of Police Department, is hereby amended to read as follows:

§ 51-9 Duties and responsibilities of Police Department.

A. No change.

B. The Police Department shall consist of the maximum set forth for each of the following positions, in addition to the Chief of Police as described in § 51-8:

(1) – (2) No change.

(3) Sergeants: [~~eight~~] thirteen positions. The Sergeants are assigned to directly supervise the three patrol shifts, the Detective Bureau and Traffic Bureau.

(4) – (7) No change.

C. No change.

All Ordinances and parts of Ordinances inconsistent herewith are hereby repealed.

III

If any section, subparagraph, sentence, clause or phrase of this Ordinance shall be held to be invalid, such decision shall not invalidate the remaining portion of this Ordinance.

This Ordinance shall take effect upon adoption and publication according to law.

EXPLANATORY STATEMENT:

This ordinance amendment increases the number of Sergeants in the Police Department from eight to thirteen.

AN ORDINANCE SETTING SALARIES
AND COMPENSATION OF CERTAIN
OFFICES, POSITIONS AND EMPLOYEES IN THE TOWNSHIP OF
FREEHOLD, COUNTY OF MONMOUTH, STATE OF NEW JERSEY,
FOR THE YEAR 2022 AND THEREAFTER KNOWN BY ITS SHORT TERM AS:

“THE 2022 SALARY ORDINANCE”

Be it ordained by the Township Committee of the Township of Freehold, in the County of Monmouth and the State of New Jersey as follows.

SECTION 1:

The full-time classified offices and positions under the Municipal Government of the Township of Freehold shall be compensated for the year 2022 within the ranges fixed in this Ordinance.

SECTION 2:

The Township Treasurer be and is hereby authorized to transfer such sums of money from the Municipal operating accounts to the payroll accounts as may be necessary to cover periodic payments.

SECTION 3:

Every person hereafter appointed to any classified or unclassified position shall receive a salary established within the pay grade for such position as provided for in this Ordinance.

SECTION 4:

Every employee who shall hereafter be promoted to another position shall, at the time of said promotion, receive a salary equal to or in excess of the minimum salary that is established for that position to which he shall have been promoted.

SECTION 5:

The following full-time classified positions in the Police Department shall be compensated in the year 2022 as follows:

TITLE: RESOLUTION TO AFFIRM THE TOWNSHIP OF FREEHOLD'S CIVIL RIGHTS POLICY WITH RESPECT TO ALL OFFICIALS, APPOINTEES, EMPLOYEES, PROSPECTIVE EMPLOYEES, VOLUNTEERS, INDEPENDENT CONTRACTORS AND MEMBERS OF THE PUBLIC THAT COME INTO CONTACT WITH MUNICIPAL EMPLOYEES, OFFICIALS AND VOLUNTEERS

- - - R E S O L U T I O N - - -

WHEREAS, it is the policy of the Township of Freehold to treat the public, employees, prospective employees, appointees, volunteers and contractors in a manner consistent with all applicable civil rights laws and regulations including, but not limited to, the Federal Civil Rights Act of 1964 as subsequently amended, the New Jersey Law against Discrimination, the Americans with Disabilities Act and the Conscientious Employee Protection Act; and

WHEREAS, the Governing Body of the Township of Freehold has determined that certain procedures need to be established to accomplish this policy;

NOW, THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED by the Township Committee of the Township of Freehold as follows:

1. No official, employee, appointee or volunteer of the Township of Freehold by whatever title known, or any entity that is in any way a part of the Township of Freehold, shall engage, either directly or indirectly in any act including the failure to act that constitutes discrimination, harassment or a violation of any person's constitutional rights while such official, employee, appointee volunteer, or entity is engaged in or acting on behalf of the Township of Freehold's business or using the facilities or property of the Township of Freehold.
2. The prohibitions and requirements of this Resolution shall extend to any person or entity, including but not limited to, any volunteer organization or inter-local organization, whether structured as a governmental entity or a private entity, that receives authorization or support in any way from the Township of Freehold to provide services that otherwise could be performed by the Township of Freehold.

3. Discrimination, harassment and civil rights shall be defined for purposes of this Resolution using the latest definitions contained in the applicable Federal and State laws concerning discrimination, harassment and civil rights.
4. The Township Administrator shall establish written procedures for any person to report alleged discrimination, harassment and violations of civil rights prohibited by this Resolution. Such procedures shall include alternate ways to report a complaint so that the person making the complaint need not communicate with the alleged violator in the event the alleged violator would be the normal contact for such complaints.
5. No person shall retaliate against any person who reports any alleged discrimination, harassment or violation of civil rights, provided however, that any person who reports alleged violations in bad faith shall be subject to appropriate discipline.
6. The Township Administrator shall establish written procedures that require all officials, employees, appointees and volunteers of the Township of Freehold as well as all other entities subject to this Resolution to periodically complete training concerning their duties, responsibilities and rights pursuant to this resolution.
7. The Township Administrator shall establish a system to monitor compliance and shall report at least annually to the Governing Body the results of the monitoring.
8. At least annually, the Township Administrator shall cause a summary of this Resolution and the procedures established pursuant to this resolution to be communicated within the Township of Freehold. This communication shall include a statement from the Governing Body expressing its unequivocal commitment to enforce this Resolution. This summary shall also be posted on the Township of Freehold's web site.
9. This Resolution shall take effect immediately.
10. A copy of this Resolution shall be published in the official newspaper of the Township of Freehold in order for the public to be made aware of this policy and the Township's commitment to the implementation and enforcement of this policy.
