FREEHOLD TOWNSHIP CURBSIDE RECYCLING RULES & REGULATIONS

MANDATORY RECYCLABLE MATERIAL: In accordance with Chapter 253 of the Freehold Township Ordinance, the following material must be separated from your regular trash and recycled:

Commingled Bottles & Cans

Glass Bottles and Jars: Do not include dishware, light bulbs, ceramics and window glass. **Aluminum Cans**: Includes soda and beer cans, etc. Do not include foil, pie tins, trays and cookware.

Tin and Bi-Metal Cans: Includes vegetable, tuna fish, and juice cans, etc. <u>NO AEROSOL OR</u> PAINT CANS!!

Plastic #1 and #2 Pourable Bottles: Includes laundry detergents, soda & milk type bottles (neck of bottle smaller than body). Do not include the following plastic containers: Oil, antifreeze, chemicals, margarine and yogurt cups, toys, food trays, etc.

Newspaper, Mixed Office Paper, Cardboard & Other Fibrous Material

Mixed Paper: Includes letterhead, colored and white paper, junk mail, soft cover books, chipboard (e.g. - cereal boxes). Do not include paper soiled with food or newspaper used for pet waste or household projects.

Corrugated Cardboard: Corrugated cardboard shall be broken down and bundled separately. Do not include food contaminated cardboard (e.g. pizza boxes) or waxed cardboard.

- Recyclables should be placed at the curb prior to 6:00 am on the scheduled collection day.
- Shall be placed in a hard sided, open container (no lids), no greater than 30 gallons in size.
 Do not put recyclables in cardboard containers, brown paper or plastic bags. RECYCLABLES IN PLASTIC BAGS WILL NOT BE COLLECTED.
- Recycling for Monday, July 4, 2022 will be picked up on Tuesday, July 5, 2022
- Recycling for Thursday, November 24, 2022 will be picked up on Friday, November 25,2022
- Recycling for Saturday December 24, 2022 will be picked up on Friday, December 23, 2022

VEHICLES LARGER THAN A PICKUP TRUCK, RACK BODY TRUCKS, ENCLOSED TRAILERS AND COMMERCIAL VEHICLES WILL <u>NOT</u> BE ALLOWED ACCESS INTO THE CENTER FOR DROP OFF.

MATERIALS NOT ACCEPTED AT THE CENTER:

- Any hazardous material, including asbestos, chemicals, oil tanks, fuels, fertilizers, household cleaners, paint and paint-related products, pesticides, thermostats containing Mercury.
 Please call the Monmouth County Household Hazardous Waste Facility in Tinton Falls at 732-683-8686 for disposal of the above items.
- Asphalt, concrete, boats, trailers, campers, cars/ car parts, construction, renovation and demolition material (examples: sheetrock, plywood, 2 x 4's etc./), dirt/sand/fill, grass clippings, sod.
- Please call the Monmouth County Reclamation center at 732-683-8686 for disposal of the above items.
- Refrigerators, freezers, air conditioners, dehumidifiers (items containing Freon (cfc's),
 Please contact a scrap metal yard for disposal of the above items numbers are listed in the telephone directory.

MATERIALS ACCEPTED AT THE CENTER:

- RECYCLABLE MATERIAL: Glass bottles and jars, tin, aluminum, steel food and beverage containers, #1 and #2 pourable plastic bottles, corrugated cardboard, mixed paper, newspaper. These items can not be placed with bulk collection.
- Appliances (except refrigerators, freezers, air conditioners or any appliance containing Freon)
- Automotive batteries, household rechargeable batteries. These items can not be placed with curbside bulk.
- Electronics (including computers, TVS, etc.).
 These items can not be placed with curbside bulk.
- Scrap metal (cut in 8' lengths)
- Lawn mowers, etc. (gasoline and oil removed)
- Used motor oil (limit of 5 gallons). This item can not be placed with curbside bulk.
- Propane tanks (empty with valve removed). This item can not be placed with curbside bulk.
- Tires limit four from autos and light trucks only (removed from rims). This item can not be placed with curbside bulk.
- BULK ITEMS: Carpet, furniture, large household items
- BRUSH, TREE PARTS and LIMBS (up to 8' in length and 8" in diameter) and small amounts of leaves (must be dumped out of bags). This item can not be placed with curbside bulk.

At the discretion of the Township of Freehold items may be added or removed at any time

SMALL BUSINESSES AND INSTITUTIONS MAY USE THE RECYCLING CENTER TO DROP OFF NO MORE THAN TWO 30 GALLON CONTAINERS OF RECYCLEABLE PAPER, BOTTLES AND CANS PER WEEK PROVIDED THEY REGISTER WITH THE TOWNSHIP CLERK.
