Call to Order

The Commission has the following comments/concerns;

- 1. The Stormwater Management Measures, Maintenance Plan & Field Manuals states that homeowners will be responsible for Drywell and Rain Gardens maintenance. There are a lot of tasks the homeowners are expected to do. How is this monitored and who does the monitoring to assure compliance?
- 2. Are there penalties for non-compliance?
- 3. Who provides training to the homeowner to complete these tasks?
- 4. What happens when a property changes hands? Who trains the new owners?
- 5. The same report says the Township is responsible for the maintenance of (7) recharge basins. Why would the township want to accept this responsibility?
- 6. Recharge Basin #7 is located between lots 23.01 and 23.02 approximately 80 feet from the roadway. A) Is this basin needed? B) If the applicant feels the Township should be responsible for the maintenance of this basin, we believe an easement would be required.
- 7. We are concerned with the overall number of structures on the property that will require on-going maintenance.
