- 2. Print out four copies of the completed application. Please note that Part I of the application must be original. No copies of this page will be accepted.
- 3. In Part A, #3, describe the type of raffle being held along with the date and time of the raffle. 50/50 and Merchandise Draw and can be held either:
 - a. On Premise tickets sold only at the time of the event. The winner does not need to be present. No Sample ticket is required for On Premise raffles.
 - b. Off Premise tickets are printed and sold prior to the day of the drawing. The winner does not need to be present. A Sample Ticket is required with the application for Off Premise raffles. (sample attached)
- 4. Please note the following for Part D Schedule of Prizes:
 - a. 50/50 raffles must award 50% of the gross receipts. Please make sure the application and sample ticket do not guarantee a specific prize amount.
 - b. Merchandise Draw raffles must include a description of the prizes being awarded along with the retail value of each prize.
 - c. Any prizes listed in this section must also be included on the sample ticket.
- 5. Any name listed in Parts F & G of the application must complete an Affidavit of Criminal History Form. (attached)

	- Four complete copies of the application (Reminder - Part I must be original)
	- Original Registration Certificate. Must be valid for entire time period stated on license application
	- Affidavit of Criminal History form for each individual listed in Sections F & G
	- Two checks for fees associated with the license. See LGCCC fee schedule attached (We recommend filling out the fee amounts at the Clerk's office)
